**RECOMMENDATIONS FORMULATED FOR SUBMISSION BY THE SOUTH
AFRICAN GOVERNMENT AND THE AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS
FOR THE ATTENTION OF THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE ON
CONSTITUTIONAL ISSUES**

In bilateral discussions between the South African Government and the African National Congress the following recommendations were formulated for submission to the Technical Committee on Constitutional Issues. This is a preliminary draft and both parties may propose modifications.

1. The schedule should be carefully checked by the constitutional committee to ensure that there are no omissions and that no legislation is being repealed which is needed in the interim period.
2. The Chief Justice and President of the Constitutional Court must be sworn in before the President. (Section 201(4) should be amended accordingly).
3. Regarding section 61(3), effect has not yet been given to the bilateral agreement.
4. Provision must be made for:
 - the alteration of the number of seats allocated to provinces in Parliament and provincial legislatures in the event of boundary changes or provinces appearing or disappearing, and
 - elections for such new provinces.
5. The phrase "the protection of the environment" should be inserted in clause 126(3)(d) between the words "economic unity," and "the promotion of".
