RESOLUTION ON THE TRANSITION PROCESS

- 1. We, the participants at the Negotiating Forum meeting at the World Trade Centre, Johannesburg on 1st and 2nd April 1993, having,
 - 1.1 Received a report from the Negotiating Council on the CODESA reports and the transition process;
 - 1.2 Identified some of the issues concerning constitutional matters which the Negotiating Council must consider.
- Resolve to instruct the Negotiating Council to consider and report on all matters arising from the Consolidated Report, including the following and other Constitutional issues:
 - * Form of State and Constitutional Principles
 - Constitution-Making Body/Constituent Assembly
 - Transitional/Interim Constitution
 - * Transitional Regional/Local Government
 - Fundamental Human Rights during the Transition
 - * Transitional Executive Council, its Sub-Councils, the Independent Elections
 Committee and the Independent Media Committee
 - * Future of the TBVC States
 - * Self-determination
- The Negotiating Council shall present reports on progress made on the above issues to the Negotiating Forum.
