



#### EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN

#### IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY AND WE ALL HAVE TO LEAVE THE CONFERENCE CENTRE

- 1. Don't panic. Try to be calm. We have planned for such an eventuality.
- Wait for instructions from security personnel and the health team. Follow instructions strictly.
- If not injured, or slightly injured but able to walk, leave the conference centre via all exits EXCEPT EXIT C (See Annexure A).
- 4. Those on Upper Floor make use of exits 1 8. (See Annexure B).
- 5. Those on Lower Floor make use of exits A. B. D. E and F.
- 6. Please do so in an orderly fashion.
- Then make your way to the helicopter pad, adjacent to the main parking area.
   Ensure one way flow of traffic only.
- 8. If you are injured, try to remain calm. Trained staff will attend to you immediately.
- Obey instructions from security personnel and the health team implicitly. They are working in your interest.
- No vehicles may be moved except those instructed to do so by security personnel. This is necessary
  in order not to disrupt evacuation procedures.
