RE: CONSTITUTIONAL PUBLIC MEETING - KWAZULU-NATAL PROVINCE

We refer to the meeting between the KwaZulu-Natal Cabinet, Ms Louisa Zondo and the writer hereof from the Constitutional Assembly held on Wednesday 22 February 1995 and once again express our appreciation for the warm reception and opportunity to address yourself and your cabinet.

We confirm our request for a person to be delegated to liaise with the team of Provincial Co-ordinators to be appointed by the Constitutional Assembly for the purpose of facilitating the Public Participation Programme in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal. The team of Provincial Co-ordinator will be operating from the offices of the South African Communication Services in Durban.

One of the important roles of the province's delegate to the team would be to create a proper communication and consultation channel with the provincial government. It is envisaged that through the said channel, adequate consultation on aspects of planning including the selection of venues for Constitutional Public Meetings (CPM's), the dates and appropriate communication mechanisms, will be facilitated.

We therefore will appreciate it if your decision regarding the delegate, representing the province in the team of provincial co-ordinators, is communicated to the writer hereof as soon as possible. As highlighted during the meeting, there is urgency in the matter as the Public Participation Programme has been launched and we are eager to have the involvement of all the provinces from the initial stages.

We further confirm the concerns, particularly from the Honourable member of the Cabinet, Prince Zulu, regarding the province's input on the training organisations to be utilized for the Constitutional Education Programme (CEP) in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal. Kindly let us have suggestions in this regards as a matter of urgency.

Kindly take note that the CEP workshop facilitated by the Community Law Centre and initially scheduled to take place on 26 February 1995 at the KwaXimba area has been postponed until further notice.

Your earliest response will be highly appreciated.
