COMMENTS: CLAUSE 194 (1) (c) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA BILL, 1996

In view of the Constitutional Court's refusal to certify the above-mentioned provision, I would like to make my views known on the issue.

I am in respectful agreement with the Constitutional Court that removal of the Public Protector from Office with a simple majority in the National Assembly does not adequately provide for and safeguard the independence and impartiality of the Office. The ideal is to take the Public Protector's removal out of the political sphere and to make certain that a decision in this regard should have the blessing of all or most parties in the Assembly. By doing so, one has a greater safeguard that the decision to remove would be an objective one based on the merits of the issue.

I would suggest a two-thirds majority, since this is the universally accepted margin for special entrenchment in constitutions.

I might also comment that it is a pity that Clause 193 (5) (b) of the Bill allows appointment of the Public Protector on a nomination approved by the National Assembly by a simple majority. Once again one would like to see the appointment taken out of the party political sphere by requiring a two-thirds majority.
