The Role of the Traditional leaders in the future South Africa.

Whereas the Constitution shall provide for a Central government, a Regional Government and a Local Government;

and

whereas the traditional leaders are not active members of any political organisation

and

whereas in the Regional and Central levels of Government the principles of democracy in the sense of elections shall apply

and

Whereas Traditional Leadership is hereditary and cannot be subjected to the principles of elections:

Wherefore the Constitution must entrench the Traditional leadership at the Local Government level;

and

Provision must be made in the Constitution for participation in the Regional and Central Government levels, only with advisory rights or powers to enable the Traditional Leaders to be informed of, and conversant with, all policies when they administer the Local Government matters.
