### RE: LEGACY PROJECT

1. The Legacy Project which has been initiated by the Administration is a recognition that we are presently custodian of a historic process. We are accordingly bound to ensure that a proper record of the process is developed.
2. It is submitted for consideration by the Management Committee that three aspects of the legacy project be considered. These are:
  - a. Archival of all records pertaining to the constitution-making process in an accessible form;
  - b. establishment of a museum/library which will contain a multi-media display and record of the constitution-making process. It is recommended that such a museum be attached to Parliament;
  - c. production of publications which will record the process and the substantive aspects of constitution-making from a technical point of view. This record should be developed with the assistance of the technical experts and members of the Panel.

### Popularisation of the Constitution

It is submitted that the Constitutional Assembly and its Administration has a stake and interest in ensuring that the final constitution be popularised amongst people of South Africa.
