**1. OPENING**

The informal meeting was opened by Ms P de Lille at 17h45.

**2. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING**

The minutes of the meeting held on 11 May 1995 were adopted.

**3. SUMMARY DOCUMENT - NATIONAL & PROVINCIAL LEGISLATIVE & EXECUTIVE COMPETENCIES**

2.1 The meeting thanked the Technical Advisors for the work which had been undertaken in the production of the report. The meeting agreed that the Technical Advisors would make minor changes (as

discussed), and the document would be circulated to the Theme Committee immediately thereafter.

- 2.2 The meeting agreed that only one Technical Advisor would be present at the Theme Committee meeting on 29 May 1995.

#### 4. FINANCIAL & FISCAL WORKSHOP 5 JUNE 1995

- 3.1 The meeting asked the Administration to obtain comparative literature on Financial and Fiscal issues relative to other countries and follow up on the request for documentation relating to tax revenue within South Africa (eg Prof Alant, CPG, World Bank).
- 3.2 The meeting agreed that the Administration would approach the Australian, Canadian, German and Nigerian Embassies inviting them to send an expert to make an input on Financial and Fiscal models applicable in their country.

#### 5. REPORT DATES

- 5.1 The meeting agreed that reports dates would not be finalised at this stage.
- 5.2 The committee expressed the concern that realistically it would be very difficult for the Theme Committee to meet the June deadline.

#### 6. PUBLIC HEARINGS

The meeting further discussed the requests for a Public Hearing and agreed that the Administration would begin planning with a view to holding a public hearing in June to which key stakeholders (eg Transvaal Municipal Association) would be invited.

#### 7. RELATIONSHIP - TECHNICAL ADVISORS & AD-HOC COMMITTEE

The Administration was asked to obtain written clarity, from the Executive Director, on the role and relationship of the Technical Advisors and the Ad-Hoc Committee.
