1. OPENING

The meeting was opened by Dr TJ King at 14h15 and the agenda was adopted.

2. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

2.1 The minutes of the meeting held on 4 May 1995 were adopted.

3. MATTERS ARISING

3.1 Public Sector Hearings / Workshops

- i. Traditional Authorities 12-13 May - Mr J Maree and Prof DC Du Toit (or an alternate) would be attending .
- ii. Commission on Provincial Government / Inter-Governmental Relations Workshop - Mr Y Carrim, Prof DC Du Toit and Dr TJ King would be attending. Mr KM Andrew would be representing Theme Committee 6.

3.2 Advertising for remainder of Blocks

The Administration advised that the Media Department has written a letter to the advertising agency expressing their concern that advertisements are not being produced timeously. The meeting expressed their concern that the advertisements and the dates for Political Party submissions would not give sufficient time for the public to make submissions.

3.3 Meeting with Prof Daniel Elazar

Due to his very busy schedule during his very short visit to Cape Town, Prof Elazar would be available to meet with interested Theme Committee members between 12h00 - 13h00 on 18 May 1995. Mr KM Andrew, Dr TJ King and representatives from the ANC would represent Theme Committee 3. (Note: Theme Committee 1 and 2 would be advised).

3.4 Internal Workshop on Inter-Governmental Relations 22 May 1995

The meeting agreed that the Administration and Professors Basson and Davis would meet immediately after the meeting to draft a letter to various embassies and to Mr Bertrus de Villiers of the Human Sciences Research Council inviting input at this workshop. The HSRC and the Commission on Provincial Government would be holding a workshop on the Institutionalisation of Inter-Governmental Relations on 18 - 19 May and the meeting agreed that speaker(s) at that workshop would be invited to address the Theme Committee, on 'practical issues', on Monday 22 May 1995.

All of the Technical Advisors are aware of the date and details of the workshop but were not invited to attend.

3.5 Local Government Beyond 2000

The Administration confirmed that documentation produced by the Workshop on Local Government Beyond 2000, held in Bloemfontein on 3, 4 and 5 April, had been circulated to all members of the Theme Committee on 11 May 1995.

3.5 Local Government Workshop 15 May 1995

The meeting agreed that the Workshop on Local Government would start at 09h00 (not 08h30). Mr André Cornelissen, Mr Blake Mosley and Mr Andrew Boraine would be presenting papers.

3.6 Public Hearing on Local Government

After considerable discussion the meeting agreed that due to time constraints of the Theme Committee and the tight schedule of the Constitutional Assembly, the Theme Committee would not be able to schedule a public hearing within the timeframe allowed for Political Party submissions on Local Government.

4.2 The meeting further agreed that:

- i. Mr KM Andrew would liaise with Prof Davis asking that he present a paper at the Workshop on Financial & Fiscal Relations, and assist in contacting people who would make a presentation on practical examples and comparative studies in other countries; and
- ii. Dr TJ King would liaise with Dr T Alant asking for documentation detailing all income accruing to the state (ie taxes collected within South Africa) for the most recent period. A breakdown would be required, at all levels of government, for each province, of income relating to for example fuel levies, gambling et al.

4.3 The meeting discussed the possibility of the parties putting together

two small committees, which would begin discussing Local Government and Financial & Fiscal Relations, so as to speed up the process.

- 4.4 The meeting noted that Prof Majola's document '*Framework on Inter-Governmental Relations - Revised Version*' would be used for Political Party submissions.
