FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS DURING THE TRANSITIONAL PERIOD LEADING
TO ELECTIONS FOR A CONSTITUTION-MAKING-BODY**

THE UPF BELIEVES THAT IN THE RUN-UP TO THE ELECTIONS FOR A CONSTITUTION MAKING BODY, CERTAIN MINIMAL-FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS SHOULD BE GUARANTEED TO ENSURE THE LEVELLING OF THE POLITICAL PLAYING FIELD, AND THESE ARE THE FOLLOWING:

1. FREEDOM OF SPEECH AND EXPRESSION;
2. FREEDOM OF THE PRESS;
3. FREEDOM OF ASSOCIATION AND DISSOCIATION;
4. FREEDOM TO FORM AND JOIN A PARTY OF ONE'S CHOICE;
5. FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT;
6. FREEDOM FROM ARBITRARY ARREST OR DETENTION;
7. FREEDOM OF THOUGHT, CONSCIENCE AND BELIEF.
