- 2. FREEDOM OF THE PRESS;
- 3. FREEDOM OF ASSOCIATION AND DISSOCIATION:
- 4. FREEDOM TO FORM AND JOIN A PARTY OF ONE'S CHOICE;
- 5. FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT:
- 6. FREEDOM FROM ARBITRARY ARREST OR DETENTION;
- 7. FREEDOM OF THOUGHT, CONSCIENCE AND BELIEF.
