BILL OF RIGHTS: CONSUMER RIGHTS AND RESPÓNSIBILITIES

The Committee of Consumer Organisations provides a forum at which the concerns of all member groups are discussed and where action can be taken on mutual causes.

A decision was taken at a recent meeting to ask that Consumer Rights should take their rightful place in any Bill of Rights that is proposed in South Africa. While the rights of the individual are dealt with, Consumer Rights, which are also universal, are not dealt with separately.

For this reason we make a strong plea that when the Bill of Rights is revised the following should be included:

Consumer Rights Consumer Responsibilities

CONSUMER RIGHTS
The United Nations Draft Guidelines for Consumer Protection sets out the following Rights:

Physical Safety
Economic Safety
Information
Education
Redress
To form Consumer Groups

RESPONSIBILITIES

Where there are rights it is axiomatic that there should be responsibilities. We therefore urge that Article 29 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights should be included in any future charter of this country. Clauses 1 and 2 state:

- Everyone has duties to the community in which alone the free and full development of the personality is possible.
- 2. In the exercise of his/her rights and freedoms, every one shall be subject to such limitations as are determined by law solely for the purpose of

securing/...

securing due recognition and respect for the rights and freedoms of others and of meeting the just requirements of morality, public order and the general welfare in a democratic society.

We are sure that the inclusion of the United Nations recommendations will provide the necessary emphasis to safegaurd the position of the Consumer in South Africa.


