
It is the N.P.P.'s very strong view that a new Electoral Act be drafted by the Technical Committee immediately.

Deferring this matter would mean that elections would not be possible in April 1994.

The draft Electoral Bill must be approved by the Multi-Party Negotiation process. If this is not done now then Parliament cannot consider it in a later session that may be held this year.

We are opposed to the Electoral Commission deciding on any Electoral Law. This is the responsibility of public representatives.
