DECISION OF FACILITATION COMMITTEE ON THE PROCESS OF THE PROCESS OF DECISION-MAKING

- 1. All decisions are to be taken by general consensus.
- 2. If this cannot be achieved, conference will use the method of <u>sufficient consensus</u>.
- 3. This means that :
 - * there is a lack of general consensus;
 - there is enough agreement from enough participants to enable the process to move forward;
 - * parties who disagree can record their objections or rejections formally in writing, but will, in the spirit of co-operation, not hinder the process to go forward and support it.
- 4. The ruling that there is consensus/sufficient consensus or not, should be taken by the chair in his/her discretion. This can, however, be challenged by any party who disagrees.
