1. OPENING AND WELCOME

- 1.1 The meeting was opened by Mr. D. Schutte who chaired the meeting.
- 1.2 The purpose of the meeting was to establish areas of overlap between Theme Committees 2, 5 and 6 with regard to Traditional Leaders.

2. CONSULTATION OF TECHNICAL EXPERTS RE TRADITIONAL LEADERS

- 2.2 The committee consulted the Constitutional Assembly document dated 2nd September 1994 containing the resolutions on the establishment of Theme Committees. The following interpretations were agreed to:-
 - 2.2.1 Theme Committee 2 Structure of Government -Point 2.10 would be interpreted to mean to represent Traditional Leaders in structures of government apart from Traditional structures.
 - 2.2.2 Theme Committee 5 Judiciary and Legal Systems -Point 5.2 interpreted to mean Indigenous Law and Point 5.4 interpreted to mean Tribal Courts.
 - 2.2.3 Theme Committee 6 Specialised Structures of Government - Point 6.7 interpreted to mean Traditional Tribal Authorities, i.e. Tribal Structures of Government.
- 2.3 It was agreed that a joint commission consisting of all 3 Theme Committees be appointed to hear evidence from Traditional Leaders and other relevant bodies.
