Submission by the ANC:

Proposal with regard to Paragraph 12B (i):

- 1. There should be a single command structure.
- 2. The command structure should be comprised of the commissioners or the deputy commissioners of the various police forces which would be described as "the Police Co-ordinating Council".
- 3. The Co-ordinating Council should report to the TEC sub-council and take instructions from the sub-council. The commissioner of the South African Police would merely be a member of the Co-ordinating Council.
- 4. The Co-ordinating Council could then appoint a single commissioner as commissioner having a specified command function in respect of all the police forces. The commissioner would be selected by the sub-council in consultation with the Co-ordinating Council. The model follows closely that which is still to be proposed in regard to the sub-council on defence. All that is required at the council meeting is for this matter to be raised on the floor and for the technical committee to be instructed to prepare a proposal in regard thereto. The advantage of such a proposal is that all the various police forces may feel inclined to buy in to the Co-ordinating council as they would be represented therein.

Proposed additional item to Item 12B "Powers and functions in regard to Law and Order, stability and Security":

8. "Notwithstanding any other law the police forces shall be bound (by any regulation governing police conduct issued by the Independent Electoral Commission, by any directive regulation or order issued by the appropriate authority governing the operation of the National Peace-keeping force and) in regard to the conduct or deployment of their members in any capacity relating to paragraph 1 (c) [of the committee's first report] to any order or directives issued by the sub-council.
