1. OPENING AND WELCOME

4. CORE GROUP REPORT

Mr. P G Marais gave a core group report and referred to the minutes attached to the document for circulation.

5. DEVELOPMENT OF WORK PLAN

- 5.1 It was agreed that each political party should make a submission to the core group with regard to the work programme. Members should also refer to the memorandum, dated the 18 October 1994, when working out their submission.
- 5.2 All submissions should be received before Wednesday, the 26 October 1994 and the core group should submit a report to all theme committee members by Friday, 28 October 1994.

- 6.2 Mr. Moorcroft sought clarity on whether the resolutions passed by the CA on the 5 September 1994, were merely guidelines for the theme committees or the only reference which theme committees could use. The house agreed that the 8 issues were guidelines and reference could be made to other material.
