SUB-COMMITTEE'S REPORT TO THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ON: RECOMMENDATION BY THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE ON FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS THAT THEIR SIXTH REPORT BE SENT FOR COMMENT TO A NUMBER OF LEGAL ASSOCIATIONS AND TO CERTAIN JUDGES

- 1. The Technical Committee on Fundamental Human Rights proposed that their seventh Report be sent for comment to
 - The Association of Law Societies
 - The General Council of the Bar
 - NADEL
 - The Black Lawyers Association
 - The Chief Justice and the Judges President

It was proposed to give them one week in which to respond.

- The Council referred this recommendation to the Planning Committee who instructed the Sub-Committee to discuss this issue with the Technical Committee. This was done on 10 August, 1993.
- It appeared that the proposal was not an unanimous one. Only one member strongly favoured this course of action while the position of others varied from less enthusiastic support to total opposition to the proposal.
- 4. After having discussed the issues thoroughly, the Technical Committee agreed to recommend that their ninth report be sent to the following bodies for comment, requesting them to respond within a week:
 - The Association of Law Societies
 - The General Council of the Bar
 - NADEL
 - The Black Lawyers Association. The Low COMMISSION
- 5. The Sub-Committee recommends that this proposal be approved.
