The W G Hart Legal Workshop 1990 will be held from Tuesday 3 July to Thursday 5 July 1990 at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies. The Commission will be holding a Reception for the speakers and delegates of the Workshop on Wednesday 4 July 1990 to which I write to invite you. The Reception will be held at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies, Charles Clore House, 17 Russell Square, London WC1B 5DR at 5.45 pm.

The subject of the Workshop this year will be Discrimination and Law. In recent years, there have been numerous practitioner-oriented conferences on sex discrimination and law but racial discrimination has been relatively neglected and raises a number of discrete issues.
