This, however, is a very serious matter and I warn to you to be careful what you say. You're not compelled to say anything which may incriminate you, but what ever you say will be taken down, and it may be used in evidence.

While I was busy delivering milk in Thornton one day during 1960, I was approached by a number of unknown bantú men. They wanted to stop me from delivering milk and told me to join P.A.C. I gave them my name and address and 25c.

Some days after that I was approached in my room in Zone 5 Langa by Makwetu and Rigala. They were organizers. They told all of us in the room to attend the meetings at Langa flats on Saturdays. They again wanted 25c. I told them I have given my 25c. They left and said they will come back again.

After that I moved to St. Columbus Home and lived there ever since.

I never joined Pogo, and never attended any Pogo meetings.

I do not know any man who is a member or organizer of Pogo. There is no Pogo Movement in the St. Columbus Home.

I have no knowledge of Pogo. I have only very recently read about Pogo in the newspapers.
