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
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
The National Assembly will elect the President from among its members at its first session. The election will require a majority of all the members of the National Assembly. Upon being elected the President shall cease to be a member of the National Assembly but will be entitled and may be called upon at any time to attend and to address the National Assembly.

- 2. The Cabinet in the Government of National Unity shall consist of representatives of parties having 5% or more of the seats in the National Assembly in proportion to the seats held by them in the National Assembly.
- 3. The Cabinet shall be appointed by the President who in making appointments of persons from political parties other than that to which the President belongs, shall act in consultation with/on the advice of after constultation with the leader of the party from which the appointment has to be made.
- 4. The Cabinet shall function as follows:
- (a) Certain decisions will require the support of two thirds of the members of Cabinet.
- (b) Other decisions will require the support a majority of the members of Cabinet.
- (c) The Cabinet will formulate directives of Cabinet policy which will regulate the way in which it will function, and the matters that are required to be brought before it. The adoption of these directives shall require the support of two thirds of the members of Cabinet.
- (d) All Cabinet Ministers will be required to comply wiht the directives of Cabinet policy and with decisions of the Cabinet.
- (e) If a Cabinet Minister fails to comply with directives of Cabinet policy or with decisions of Cabinet, he may be dismissed by the President.
