CHANGES TO DRAFT 3 OF THE REPORT . ANY COMMENTS TO HENNIE
BESTER BY 4PM TODAY!

Please note the following changes to draft 3 as at 12h00 this morning.

1. Paragraph 4.2 is deleted in its entirety, as it was felt that, since there is no other reference in the report to any specific party's report or point of view, neither should there be such a reference in this instance. The numbering of the rest of paragraph 4 is adjusted accordingly.
2. Paragraph 6.1.3.3 - delete all the words after political activity. This then reflects the original agreement.
3. Paragraph 6.1.7.2
Delete the word "it" in line 3 and insert "the legislation". In line 4 delete the word "removing" and insert the words "to remove". The changes clarify the meaning of the paragraph.
4. Paragraph 6.1.7.3
Delete all the words after "task group" in line 1 and before "be appointed" in line 4. This would be more in accord with the factual situation that the composition of such a task group must be ratified by Codesa 2 and that individuals would be present in their capacity as representatives of parties, organisations or governments.
5. Paragraph 9.1.4
Delete acronym SAICC and insert in its place SAITCOM (South African Independent Telecommunications Commission).
6. Paragraph 9.1.9
Insert at the beginning the introductory paragraph the following sentence:

"There was no consensus on a proposal regarding the immediate reconstitution of the board of the SABC." Insert in line 1, as it stands at the moment, after the words "it was", the word "however".

This amendment is in line with the practice throughout the document to note proposals which were extensively discussed, but on which no consensus could be reached.

7. Paragraph 14

Delete the second sentence of the paragraph. Delegations have pointed out that the sentence concerned was in fact not part of the formal consensus reached.

8. Paragraph 21.1

Delete the said paragraph in its entirety and insert the following:

"22.1 It was agreed that a task group be set up in relation to the process of elections to invite a neutral independent international body. The task group shall determine:

21.1.1 The terms of invitation;

21.1.2 The scope of responsibility;

21.1.3 All other matters concerning such an undertaking."

9. Paragraph 21.3

Delete the word "should" in line 2 and insert the word "shall". This change reflects the original agreement.

10. Paragraph 22: The way forward

This paragraph was inserted on the request of the steering committee to the rapporteur to draft something on the way forward. It was therefore merely a proposal to be suitably amended by members of the steering committee. After receiving further suggestions, the following wording is proposed:

NB { "22. The WG had insufficient time to discuss and agree on the future handling of matters following within the ambit of its assignments and terms of reference. However, the following proposals are put forward for consideration by Codesa:

22.1 Various agreements reached require implementation by legislation. It is proposed that, in view of the past involvement of the participants with the relevant matters, and the existing expertise, the SC of WG1 be mandated to receive and approve draft legislation from any source.

22.2 It is proposed that a task group, referred to in 6.1.7.3 above, be set up to discuss and make recommendations on:

22.2.1 The implementation of agreed amendments to the Public Safety Act, 1953 (6.1.6.2 above);

22.2.2 The substitution of current security legislation (6.1.7.2 above);

22.2.3 Proposals regarding the amendment/repeal of discriminatory legislation (6.2.2. above).

22.3 It is proposed that Codesa decides on appropriate mechanisms to implement the agreements recorded in 21 above (the role of the international community)."
