Describe what happened: The presiding officer decided to leave sealed ballots ^{boxes} (recorded) ballot papers official stamps, seal in SMUTS HALL ON Robber Island. I felt that maybe it was ~~unsafe~~ unsafe to leave all the ballots, seals even though the prison officials said they would be safe.

What did you do about it? I reported to both presiding officer + I.E.C. monitor how I felt. Both the I.E.C. offices felt it was necessary to phone I.E.C. head office to see what the policy was. It was said that it was O.K.

What action was taken by the Presiding Officer or other officials? A ~~per~~ inventory form was written on all the contents left. Then it was sealed in a plastic bag. The day ran smoothly. The next day everything was double checked and fine.

HOW TO FILL IN THE VOTING STATION REPORT

Filling in the report will help you to do your job to:

- * check voters are moving through the voting station smoothly;
- * identify problems so they can be sorted out quickly.

Number: Here is what you must do:

- 1 Write down the name of the place being used for the voting station. For example: Community Hall, Stilbaai.
- 2 Write down the IEC code for the voting station. Your zone has a list from the IEC, get before you start work. example: A0708
- 3 Mark off the date.
- 4 Enter the time you fill in the form. It has to be done at 10.30, 2.30 and close of voting.
- 5 Ask the presiding officer how many ballots have been issued up to that time in the day, then write down the number.
- 6 To find out how many minutes people have to wait in the queue, note the time a person you will remember joins the queue and then see how much time passes before they get to the table.

You now have to judge whether there were problems up to that point and say yes or no to each one.

- 7 Did some voters have problems reading and writing? You can tell if they were confused or asked for help.
- 8 Are voters being intimidated by police? Are they making threatening gestures, making remarks that voters feel uncomfortable with or threatening or using violence.
- 9 Are other parties intimidating voters? Are they insulting voters, or threatening reprisals or violence.
- 10 Are gangsters intimidating voters? Are they present and are they insulting voters, or threatening reprisals or violence or attacking voters.
- 11 Are right wingers intimidating voters? Are they present and are they making remarks or threatening or using violence.
- 12 Is the voting station overcrowded? Are the number of people inside causing voters to struggle to move through each voting step.
- 13 Are there long delays? Check delays in getting ID books checked, or scanned for dye, or being given the ballot.
- 14 Were many people turned away? People without valid ID or have already voted or have arrived after 7pm.
- 15 Is the monitoring bad? Are party agents in their posts, are monitors observing proceedings.
- 16 Judge the security and marshalling in and around the voting station. Is it bad, Ok or good.
- 17 Do you need outside help to sort out problems?
- 18 Write down any other problems that have come up since you last reported that are not covered on the form.
- 19 Then write down your name and sign the form.

When the form is complete hand it to person who will take it to the ANC information center outside the voting station.

HOW TO FILL IN THE ANC INFORMATION CENTRE REPORT

- 20 Fill in your name.
- 21 Fill in your contact telephone number being used for the information centre (it could be a ANC supporters house nearby).
- 22 Mark off if you need help.
- 23 Mark off how quickly you need help. Try and solve problems yourself. (Immediate local action is very important).
- 24 Write down what actions you have taken to solve problems to keep the zone fully informed.
- 25 Mark off which party you guess is getting the most votes.
