### REPORT NO. 9

---

1. Evaluation complete for CPM's. Operations Team is being restructured to incorporate sector work. Operations Team presently drafting manual for CPM's.
2. Prospective CPM dates for April/May and June are, April 27th - thereafter every weekend until the 25th May 1995 except the weekend of the 29th April to the 1st of May 1995 (which is a public holiday). Consultation with Premiers for the Northern Transvaal venues and Eastern Transvaal complete. Other Premier consultation to be completed by Maphelo between 27th March and 10th April 1995. Wayne Morris will also be visiting SACS Regional Offices together with Maphelo during this time. Maphelo visited Constitutional Committee of Eastern Cape on the 17th March 1995. They have divided their province into 3 sub-regions for the purpose of the CPM's. They wish to conduct their own CPM Programme and possibly have unrealistic expectations regarding our participation in their programme and our programme in their region.

Met with Brigadier Potgieter of SAAF to reach understanding re their procedure.

- x 3. **Sector Work** - Issue of Sector Co-ordinators and Deputy Co-ordinator needs to be resolved. CL met with Secretariat re sector work and a proposal for issue-based sector work may emerge. Need Business SA feedback.
- x 4. **CEP** - Project Managers and Programme Managers have completed interviewing in the Provinces and have made their recommendations to Directorate. They will be submitting these together with a programme for the CEP for consideration by the Chairpersons.
5. **Staffing** - Interviews for admin secretaries are currently underway.
6. **Workshop** - Workshop with Media Department planned for either 25th March or 10th April 1995.
7. Directorate's decision required re 2 students that have applied to do volunteer internships. See attached C.V.'s
- x 8. Directorate's decision required re C.L. office coherency - if we move from Regis House to Parliament Street (partly or as a whole department) what does it mean for internal C.L. communication and inter-departmental communication?.

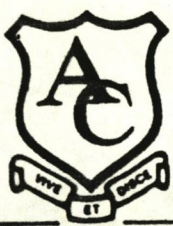

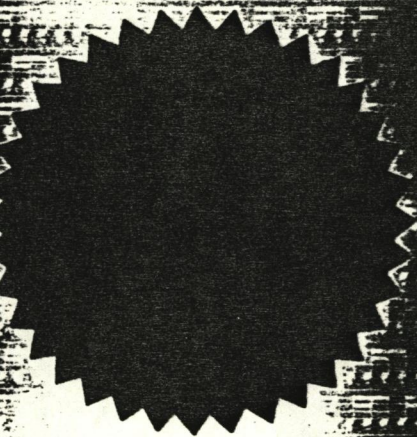

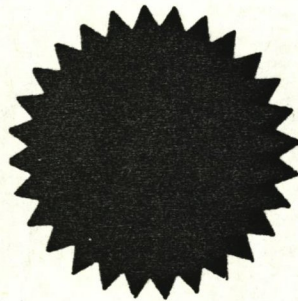
