- 3.1 Organisations must ensure that personnel sent for various functions have an aptitude in accord with these functions.
- 4. RECOMMENDATIONS:
- 4.1 An estimate formulation of functions should be supplied to security beforehand.
- 4.2 The basic security management functions must be consolidated in advance so that the planning implementation and control of various security activities can be done effectively and efficiently.
- 4.3 In future, in order to increase the Espirit de Corpse amongst the CODESA security, the members should be allowed to be together at least three days before the operation starts, in order to familiarise themselves within the area of operations and other members.
