SUBJECT: PARTICIPATION OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS IN THE CONVENTION

FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOUTH AFRICA (CODESA)

PREAMBLE:

RECOGNISING that Traditional Leaders have a role to play in the structuring of a democratic, non-racial, non-sexist new South Africa;

RECOGNISING that the said role derives from the position Traditional Leaders hold among their subjects since time immemorial;

ACCEPTING that the position of Traditional Leaders is non-political and non-partisan;

ACCEPTING that Traditional Leaders, are quite capable of deciding for and among themselves how best their interests should be presented and thus how they should be represented in CODESA; and

BEING mindful and conscious of the decision taken by the CODESA Management Committee about the proposal to seek evidence of scholars and experts on Traditional Leadership;

NOW THEREFORE; the Transkei Kings and Chiefs propose that:

- Traditional Leaders should be accorded full participation in 1. CODESA;
- A special meeting of all Traditional Leaders (Kings and 2. Chiefs) be convened by the CODESA Management Sub-Committee to discuss the modalities of their representation and par ticipation, as well as to elect their representatives in terms of their resolutions at the proposed special meeting.
- Only thereafter, if still necessary, should the evidence 3. of scholars and experts be sought.
