REQUEST FOR FURTHER PARTICULARS

On behalf of Accused No's. 2 to 34 (both inclusive) and 36 to 79 (both inclusive), application is hereby made in terms of Section 179(1) of the Criminal Procedure Act 1955, for the furnishing of the following further particulars to the annexure to the Charge Sheet in the abovementioned matter:

A. 1. With regard to each of the persons mentioned in Paragraph (a) of the Charge Sheet:-

- (i) On what date was he or she either assaulted, injured or threatened;
- (ii) At approximately what time of the day did this take place;
- (iii) Precisely where did this take place;
- (iv) What was the nature of the alleged assault, injury or threat?
- (v) Which of the accused is alleged to have assaulted, injured or threatened the complainant?

B. 1. With regard to each of the allegations in paragraph (b):

- (i) On what date was each of the premises and/or property either damaged, burnt or destroyed;
- (ii)/.....

- (ii) At what time of the day did this take place.
 - (iii) Precisely where did this take place;
 - (iv) Which of the Accused is alleged to have damaged, burnt or destroyed the premises and/or property in question?
- C. Is it intended to be alleged that the events detailed in paragraphs (a) and (b) of the Charge Sheet constituted one continuous transaction? If not, what is intended to be alleged?
- D. With regard to each of the abovementioned Accused:
- (i) Is it alleged that he himself committed any of the particular acts of violence detailed in paragraphs (a) and (b) of the Charge Sheet, and if so, which?
 - (ii) If it is not so alleged, then by virtue of what facts is it sought to hold the Accused liable?
- E. (i) Is it alleged that the Accused or any of them convened a crowd or that they merely joined a crowd which had already gathered?
- (ii) If it is alleged that any of the Accused convened a crowd full details are required of time, place and manner of such convening.
 - (iii) If it is alleged that the Accused merely joined a crowd, full details are required as to when and where each Accused joined the crowd, and when and where he left the crowd.
