The basic success of CODESA depends on accommodation between the participants to achieve the goals set out in the Declaration of Intent. We feel that there should be constant pressure on all to achieve consensus, and that modalities and procedures which have the effect of delaying ~~decisions~~ decisions or of encouraging opportunistic deals in order to secure votes, should be avoided.
