During 1960 I joined the P.A.C. I was arrested during that year under the Emergency Regulations and was detained for one month, but I was not convicted. I was persuaded by a man known to me as Xintolo to join the P.A.C. I also know that the P.A.C. was banned.

I know Thongoye. He was the first man to speak to me about joining Poqo. It was during May, 1963 that I was forst approached by this man. I was at the time living in St. Columbus Home. Chongoye held a meeting there and said that Poqo was to fight the White people. I did not agree and did not join Poqo. A man known to me as Cogella was with Chongoye. They both spake to the people about Poqo. I was under the impression that both of them were leaders of Poqo.

I moved from Columbus Home during the end of Oct., 1962.

I have not seen Cogella or Thongoye since. I did not at any time join Poqo and did not attend any meetings. I never gave any money towards Pogo. P. 7.0.
