REPORT FOR NATIONAL WORKING COMMITTEE ON FINALISATION OF LIST

FROM: Office of the Secretary General

DATE: 11 January 1994

1. BACKGROUND

You will recall that the NEC meeting of 27 - 29 August 1993 endorsed a process for formulating the ANC List for elections on 27 April 1994. This report is intended to update NWC members on progress in the process thus far and apprise the NWC of the process to be followed by the NEC in finalising the list. Some decisions are required to ensure we complete the process in time. These are outlined below in the relevant sections.

2. REGIONAL CONFERENCES

In terms of this process, nominations were opened at local level with ANC branches, the Alliance and PF structures. These nominations were then taken to a series of conferences 1993, at regional level at which elections took place for all three lists: namely, Provincial Legislatures, Regional List for National Assembly and National List for National Assembly.

These conferences have all now taken place. The results for the Regional List to the N.A. and Provincial Legislature were sent to regions on Monday 3 January 1994. These lists were ordered according to the number of votes received by each candidate.

The results for the National List to the N.A. have also been sent to regions. These have been presented in alphabetical form, listing the first 200 positions (01 - 200), followed by the second 200 positions (201 - 400).

NO DECISION REQUIRED

3. PROVINCIAL CONFERENCES

Following the regional conferences, provincial conferences were neccessary in the ff. areas to arrive at provincial legislature lists:

- * Eastern Cape: Eastern Cape, Border and Transkei
- * Natal: Southern Natal, Natal Midlands and Northern Natal
- * Orange Free State: Northern OFS and Southern OFS

These conferences have also all now taken place. Note that elections did not take place at these conferences. A process was agreed upon, by all the regions concerned, that, instead of voting, representatives from each region should draw up a provincial list basing themselves upon the results of regional conferences and ensuring the principle of affirmative action was followed.

This was done, and the resulting list presented to each provincial conference and accepted by delegates.

The List Committee is presently looking at these lists to ensure that the process of ordering the Provincial List did indeed follow regional conference results and that affirmative action has been implemented.

NO DECISION REQUIRED

4. RATIONALISATION OF LISTS

In addition to the Provincial conferences held above, it is neccessary to rationalise lists for provincial legislature and the regional list for the national assembly in some areas. This is so because some areas of one region will in fact fall in another province in terms of electoral boundaries.

Thus, for example, in the North West Province, in addition to the candidates elected by the Western Transvaal regional conference, parts of PWV and Northern Cape region who now fall into the new province, are entitled to nominate candidates. This is presently

taking place under the guidance of the REC's concerned and the List Committee. At the end of the process, a list for the North West Province will emerge.

Other regions are also affected by the new provincial boundaries and thereto, the process of arriving at a final provincial list is similar to that above, again under the direction of the List Committee.

NO DECISION REQUIRED

5. PROVINCIAL PREMIER

Elections for Premier took place at all the above regional conferences, with the exception of Western Cape. After the Provincial Conferences, the results for Premier in all regions are as follows:

S.OFS and N.OFS regional conferences)

5.6 N. Cape - Manne Dipico (unopposed)

5.7 Western Cape

The Premier for Western Cape will be elected when the regional nominations conference reconvenes on Sunday 16 January 1994.

5.8 North West

The position of Premier for the North West Province remains to be finalised. The results of the Western Transvaal regional

conference were that Essop Pahad was elected after defeating the second nominee, Rocky Malebane Metsing by 236 votes to 151. However, because very substantial areas of PWV and Nothern Cape will also fall into this province, additional nominations for Premier from these areas, which were not part of the Western Transvaal conference are still being considered. A final candidate for premier of the province will be agreed upon by all three regions in consultation with the List Committee.

6. FINALISATION OF LISTS

6.1 Objections

Any objections to names appearing on the lists were placed in an objection box at the conferences. These have been forwarded to the List Committee and will be taken to the NEC for decision.

6.2. Affirmative Action

The NEC decision on affirmative action is presently being applied to the Provincial Legislature lists and the Regional Lists for the National Assembly to ensure that at least one third of the final lists are women.

After the National Nominations Conference on 15 January 1994, the NEC decision will also be implemented with regard to the National List for the National Assembly.

6.3. Confirmation of Acceptance for Nomination

The List Committee is presently confirming, together with regions, the acceptance or withdrawl by all nominees of their nomination. Where a nominee is withdrawing, this is required in writing. This process will continue until the NEC meets to finalise all lists.

NO DECISION REQUIRED

7. NATIONAL NOMINATIONS CONFERENCE

A national ballot for the National List to the National Assembly is

presently being compiled. Elections will then take place at a National Nominations Conference to be held on 15 January 1994 at which all ANC regions, SACP, COSATU and the PF will be represented.

ANC regions at this conference have been accorded representation using a formula which combines both population size and size of membership, and at the same time includes some affirmative action and a minimum delegation size for smaller regions.

The conference will be facilitated by IMSSA.

NO DECISION REQUIRED

8. FINALISATION BY NWC/NEC

In terms of the NEC decision of 27 - 29 August 1993, the NWC/NEC will finalise all the lists, provided that only changes supported by over 2/3rds of either structure is considered.

8.1 NEC Process

The process that is envisaged for the NEC is as ff:

A sub-committee of the NEC and members of the List Committee, will meet on Sunday 16 January 1994 whilst the NEC is in session. This sub-committee will look at all the lists (Provincial Legislature, Regional List to National Assembly and National List to National Assembly.)

They will be responsible for ensuring that the criteria agreed upon by the NEC in August last year with regard to the composition of the list have been met. This relates to issues such as overall representation of regions, race, class and social groups we want represented in our lists. In addition, they will look at the objections received to candidates on the list.

The sub-committee will then report to the NEC on Monday 17 January 1994, at which a penultimate list will be decided upon.

Note however, that whilst objections and political issues will be handled by the NEC on this day, it will still not be possible to finalise the lists because of the many duplications that occur i.e. candidates who appear on more than one list. These individuals have to be afforded the opportunity to choose which list they wish to appear on.

This decision must be reached by Friday 21 January 1994 when the NEC will reconvene at 07h00 before the National Conference on Reconstruction and Strategy commences, to finalise the lists.

However, the results of the NEC decision on Monday 17 January will be made immediately available to the public, stating that these are the final ANC lists for 27 April, subject to individual candidates choosing which list they wish to appear on in the case of duplication. Should candidates have failed to decide by 21 January, the NEC will have no option but to make the decision itself.
