We thank you for your prompt response to our request for names of security volunteers. However, in assessing the situation we have concluded that there is no need for a concentration of security personnel at the WTC. In our assessment, it would be sufficient to have two instead of five people to serve as part of the CODESA security personnel team for the month of February. These two volunteers will then return home at the end of February and be replaced by the ~~remaining~~ ^{remaining} volunteers from your organisation for the month of March.

attention

There will be a briefing meeting for these two volunteers, along with the rest of the volunteers from other organisations, on 4 February, 9am, WTC.

These volunteers will be provided with food and accommodation nearby the WTC. In addition a shuttle service between their accommodation and the WTC will be provided.

All security personnel are kindly requested not to wear their customary uniforms. The Security Committee requests that the men wear instead a blue blazer, white shirt, black tie and shoes.

On the question of weapons: No weapons (traditional or otherwise) are to be brought by volunteers. If required, fire arms and requisite training will, be provided.

Identification: All volunteers reporting for duty must produce identity documents.

Two persons from each party will be asked to check into their accommodation on Monday 3/2/92 and to report for duty at 06h00 on Tuesday 4/2/92.

It should be noted that no more names will be accepted. The list is now closed.

Travel + Accommodation arrangements for personnel to reach ~~WTC~~ - ^(WTC) - New 4/2 - can be arranged by contacting Elize Sturges or Jenny at (012) 323-3506. After arrival at the WTC, representatives will be registered and then transported to New accommodation.
