

THE UPF ENDORSES THE PROPOSAL'S AS SUBMITTED BY THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE TO IMPROVE EFFICIENCY AND TO FACILITATE THE URGENT IMPL'EMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENTS MADE IN THE VARIOUS WORKING GROUPS. WE BEL'IEVE THAT A PERIOD OF FOUR WEEKS WILL' BE REASONABL'E FOR THE PL'ENARY SESSION TO COME TOGETHER TO ENDORSE THE PROGRESS MADE AND UPF SUPPORTS A PROPOSAL' THAT THE PL'ENARY SESSION RECONVENE BY THE END OF JUNE BEFORE PARL'IAMENT SESSION ADJOURNS. MAY WE FURTHER STATE THAT THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE SHOUL'D ENSURE THAT THE APPOINTMENT OF THE SUBCOUNCIL'S AND TECHNICAL' COMMITTEES SHOUL'D BE SUCH THAT PARTICIPATING ORGANIZATIONS AND GOVERNMENTS ARE NOT PREJUDICED IN ANY MANNER.

FURTHERMORE, WE IN THE UPF WISH TO STATE CATEGORICALLY THAT AS PATRIOTIC SOUTH AFRICANS WHO PLACE THE NATIONAL' INTERESTS ABOVE SECTIONAL' ONES, FULLY ENDORSE THE SENTIMENTS EXPRESSED BY THE L'EADER OF THE ANC WITH SPECIFIC REFERENCE, AMONG OTHERS, TO THE IMMEDIATE INTRODUCTION OF L'EGISL'ATION BY THE TRICAMERAL' PARL'IAMENT TO ENABLE THE EL'ECTION OF AN INTERIM TRANSITIONAL' EXECUTIVE BODY TO DRAFT A NEW CONSTITUTION. SUCH A CONSTITUTION WILL, WE AGREE, BE APPROVED OF BY A SINGLE SUPREME PARL'IAMENT FOR THE WHOL'E COUNTRY.

FURTHERMORE, WE ENDORSE THE PRINCIPL'E THAT THE EL'ECTION OF THAT BODY WILL BE CONDUCTED BY AN INDEPENDENT EL'ECTORAL' COMMISSION WHICH SHOUL'D ENL'IST THE ASSSITANCE OF AN INTERNATIONAL' MONITORING BODY TO ENSURE THAT THE ELECTIONS ARE FREE AND FAIR. HOWEVER, TO FACILITATE THAT PROCESS MR. CHAIRPERSON, AS L'EADERS OF THE RESPECTIVE POLITICAL' ORGANIZATIONS OR GOVERNMENTS, WE MUST TAKE IT UPON OURSEL'VES TO BRING VIOL'ENCE AND INTIMIDATION TO AN END AS SO ADEQUATELY STATED BY THE STATE PRESIDENT HERE THIS MORNING, EXCEPT AS A POINT OF DEPARTURE THAT THE GOVERNMENT IS PRESENTLY FAIL'ING TO MAINTAIN LAW AND ORDER IN THE COUNTRY. THE DAYS OF POL'ITICAL' POSTURING AND MUDSL'INGING EXERCISES MUST NOW GIVE WAY TO A NEW SPIRIT OF RECONCI-L'IATION AND RECONSTRUCTION, OF TOGETHERHEID AND NOT APARTHEID. IF WE ARE SERIOUS AND DEDICATED TO OUR COMMITMENT TO PEACE AND STABILITY, AS L'EADERS WE MUST REFRAIN FROM WAR TAL'KS AND JOINTLY HOL'D PEACE RALL'IES IN THE AFFECTED COMMUNITIES.

IN THIS TASK, THE ISSUE OF AN INDEPENDENT MONITORING BODY SUCH AS THE OAU AND/OR OTHER ORGANIZATIONS AS WELL AS THE JOINT CONTROL OF THE SECURITY FORCES REMAINS OF PARAMOUNT IMPORTANCE. THIS WILL IN MY VIEW, NOT ONLY GIVE CREDIBILITY TO THE SECURITY FORCES BUT WILL REDUCE TO A MINIMUM, THE ATROCITIES PURPOTEDLY COMMITTED BY HIT SQUADS THAT ARE ALLEGEDLY ALLEGATIANT TO THE PRESENT SECURITY FORCES.

I WANT IN CONCLUSION TO REMIND WITH ALL HUMILITY
