#### MEMORANDUM

TO: All ANC Departments/Sections/Desks All ANC Regions.

At a Heads of Department's Meeting held 18th June, 1992, it was agreed to urgently convene a Workshop to evaluate the advantages/disadvantages of engaging with various Government Departments, parastatals and other state-funded institutions.

Increasingly key ANC members are being singled out to participate in processes to reach concensus around strategic policy issues, and are even being offered employment or positions on Boards/Trusts etc. Do these engagements advance the cause of the ANC by us being able "to influence them", or are we legitimizing these institutions in the sense of them being able to say "we have consulted with the ANC" or the "the ANC is part of the process"?

It was felt that we should look at various types of engagements we are involved in, viz:

- -social, informal meetings
- -formal meetings
- -addressing conferences, workshops, seminars
- -taking up employment
- -serving on Boards, panels, committees etc
- -taking up consultancies, etc.

We would also have to look at the different levels at which these engagements occur, such as NEC/elected leadership level; Head of Department level; Departmental representatives; ANC staff members or individual ANC members.

The Heads of Department's Meeting of the 18th June, 1992, assigned the following four comrades to organise the Workshop: Shaheed Rajie (convenor); And le Ngcaba, Ralph Ngijima and Frene Ginwala.

Tentatively the Workshop is sheduled for the <u>week-end of 18-19th</u>, <u>ully 1992. In Johannesburg</u> and we envisage participation drawn from the N C and all Departments and Regions(2 per Region). It would be useful if the Regions could start the process of selecting/preparing their delegates as soon as possible. A draft programme will soon be circulated.

To facilitate preparations please fill in the attached questionaire by the end of June and return to Faith Mnisi (Phone: 3307178; Fax: 011-3334509). This would enable the organisers to compile a factual report of the actual state of engagement.
