LETTERS

No civil war if Right is involved in Codesa

We are worried by the spate of bombings which have recently engulfed the country. The Right is suspected.

On the other hand we have also the slaying of unsuspecting policemen by Apla (Azanian Peoples Liberation Army), criminals and the ANC's MK-cum-Defence Units. The attacks on isolated farmers and their families are not just criminal action but are orchestrated by political organisations.

Peter Mkaba, a leader of the ANC Youth League and member of the ANC National Executive, has called on the masses to arm themselves by disarming the whites and police and thus providing weapons for the Defence Units. What is happening is the implementation of his directives. Apla has given these elements a cover to implement their nefarious plans.

The consequences of

this sort of violence will be sharp racial polarisation — ghastly to contemplate. Farmers will form self-defence units which will carry out reprisals against suspected blacks and even attack any strange blacks in the neighbourhood.

The Government seems paralysed by the ANC propaganda and rhetoric. They perceive the ANC to have a large support among Blacks, which is a very wrong assessment. This will result in the police forming secret vigilante groups, taking the law into their own hands to de-activate some activists they suspect of being involved in their extermination. There are also individuals who are now well armed and have started to revenge themselves against those comrades who necklaced their relatives or burnt down their properties.

To avoid a civil war which will devastate our

people and the economy, we need to accommodate the Right in Codesa. We need to negotiate which part of South Africa can be a Boerestaat, also the relations of this state with greater South Africa, eg a federal or confederal relationship. The Boere as Christians fear control by the SACP/ANC and want their own Christian state.

The Government must act swiftly and decisively. If violence and crime escalate at the present rate, they must also consider seriously the imposition of a state of emergency.

We know that those who want anarchy will appeal to the international community to impose sanctions. But the world and Africa have sobered up and Africa is showing withdrawal symptoms from the Marxist drug abuse.
