#### XIMORO PROGRESSIVE PARTY

- action and dialogue embodied in the principle of free association, the establishment of the right to civil liberties and the rule of law which upholds a democratic society based on common citizenship and loyalty to one South Africa.

We therefore meet in a cordial spirit to begin the process of hammering out a constitution which, when approved by the majority of the people of South Africa, will :-

- ensure the formation of a multi-party government;
- establish the necessary machinery to uphold basic human rights with equality for all before the law;
- facilitate the realisation of social conditions to promotoe equal employment, educational and health facilities for all;

- ensure an effective division of powers and functions between the legislative, executive and judicial authority;
