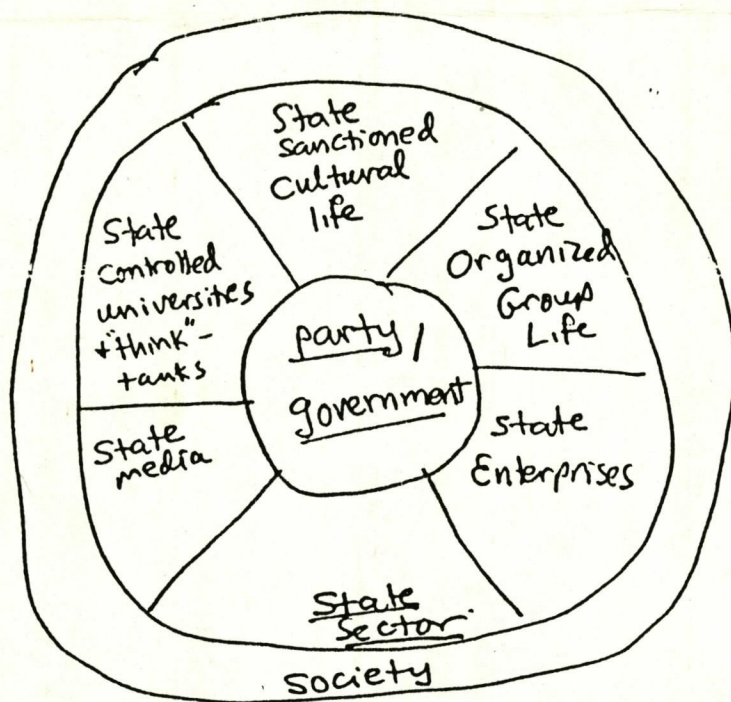

A Communist/Totalitarian System

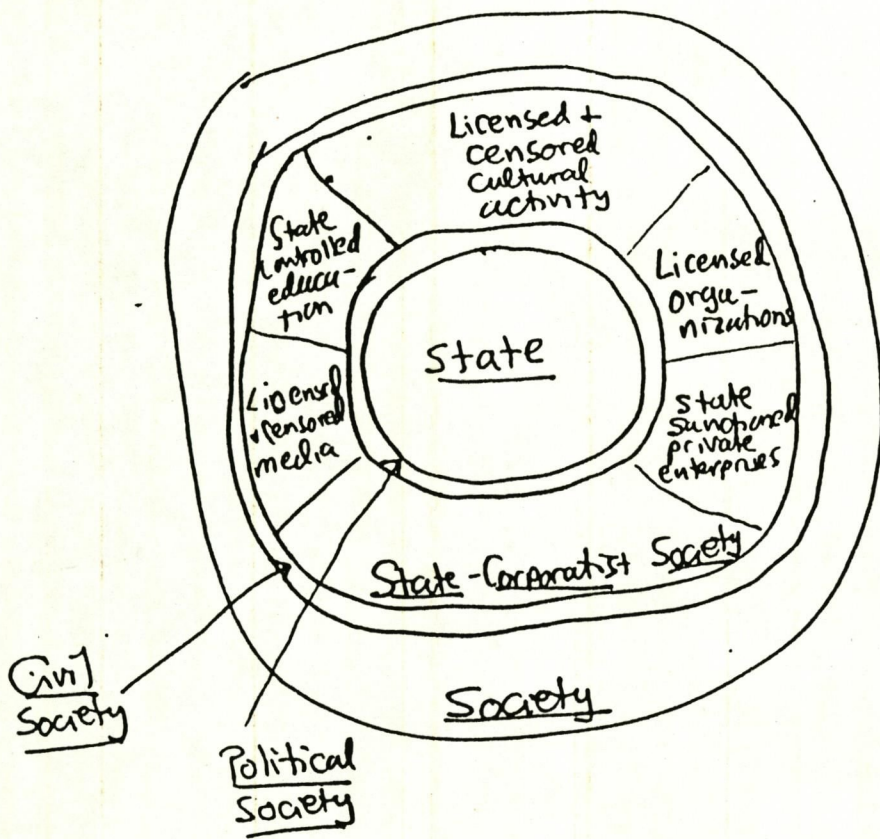

An Authoritarian-Corporatist System

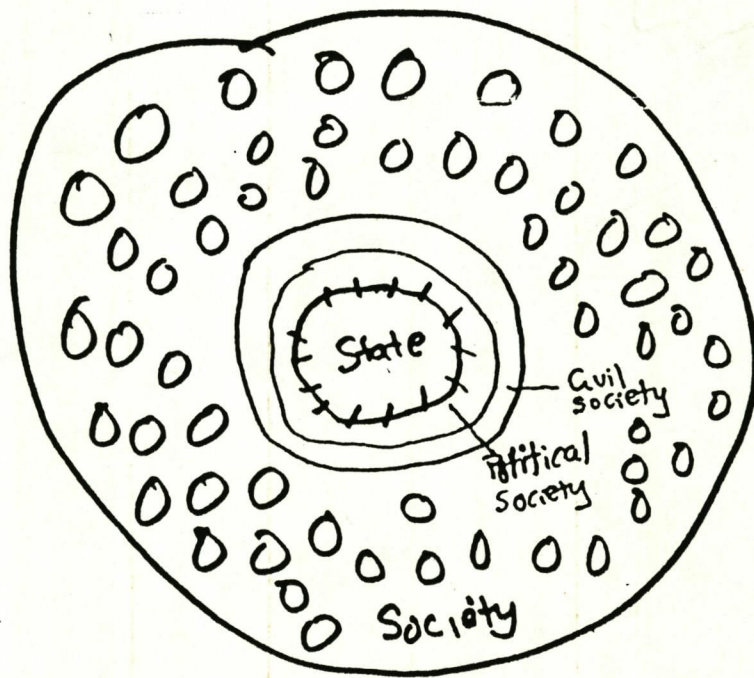
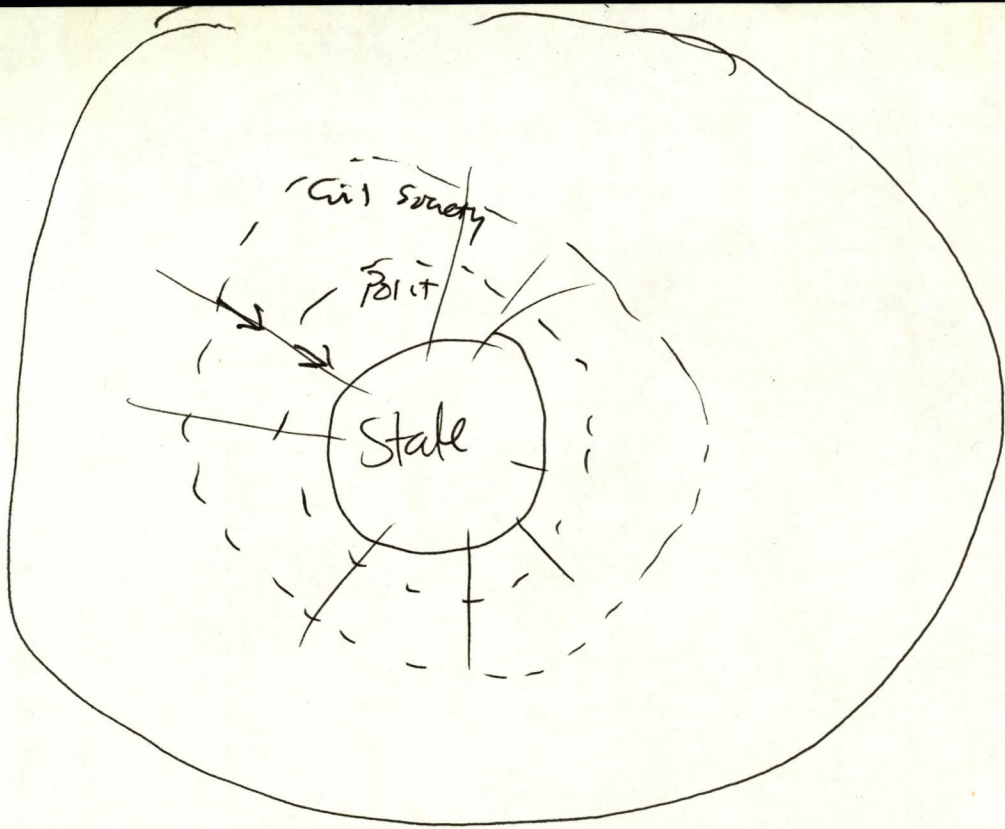


Figure 4 Weak State, Weak Civil Society
