- (6) Little law and order.

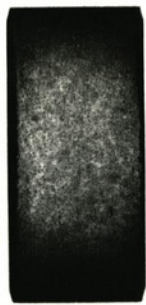
On the credit side with the advent of Madela we have continued violence which may help reduce the black population.
