Members of nine out of the ten Political Groups in the European Parliament, including the leaders of four of the Groups have endorsed a statement initiated by the Liaison Group of National Anti-Apartheid Movements of the European Community. They call for the "establishment of an Interim Government for the period of transition". They also support the adoption of a new non-racial constitution and recognize that the National Party's constitutional proposals - published in September - "seek to entrench white minority rule in a new form". The 176 signatories represent one third of the members of the European Parliament.

The campaign is aimed at securing the European Community's support for the peace process and in particular the establishment of an Interim Government.

### STATEMENT ON SOUTH AFRICA

The Community and its Member States welcome the announced start of the Convention for a Democratic South Africa which can be a milestone on the way to a united, democratic and non-racial South Africa.

They have accepted the invitation from the two co-chairpersons of CODESA to participate as an observer in this historic meeting which is scheduled to take place on 20 and 21 December 1991 in Kempton Park.

Evidence of the need for a broad consensus among all parties on the shape of the new South Africa, the Community and its Member States launch an urgent appeal to all those parties who have not yet decided to participate in the upcoming negotiation process. It is essential that all parties should do so in order not to miss this unique opportunity for reconciliation through dialogue.
