THE TEAMSITION TO A DEMOCRATIC AND NON-EAGLAL SOUTH AFRICA: A POBBIELE SCHNARIO. FEERUARY, 1992.

- 1.0. CODERA AGREPS THAT THE PURPOSE OF THE CONVENTION IS TO LAY THE BASIS FOR THE POLITICAL TRANSFORMATION OF SOUTH AFRICA FROM AN APARTHEID TO A NON-BACIAL AND DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY. (THE ERGAD OUTCOME IS DEFINED IN THE "DECLARATION OF INTENT".)
 - 2.0. CODESA AGREES THAT THE END REBULT OF ITS DECISIONS IS THE ADOPTION OF A CONSTITUTION FRAMED WITHIN THE PARAMETERS CONTAINED IN THE "DECLARATION OF INTENT".
 - 3.0. CODEBA AGREES THAT SUCH A CONSTITUTION WILL SE DEANN UP BY AN ELECTED BODY.
 - 3.1. CODERA AGREES THAT SUCH ELECTICAS WILL BE CONDUCTED ON THE SABIB OF ONE PERSON, ONE VOTE, WITH NO DISTINCTION HEING HADE ON THE BASIS OF RACE, COLOUR OR GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION OF THE ELECTORS.
 - 3.2. COUPEA AGREES THAT ALL SOUTH AFRICANS OF THE AGE OF IS AND ABOVE WILL BE ENTITLED TO VOTE.
 - 3.3. CODERA AGREEM. THAT SOUTH AFRICA WILL SE UNDERSTOOD TO BE THE TREETTURY DEFINED AS BOUTH AFRICA UNDER THE ACT OF

UNION OF 1909, UNLESS TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES HAVE BEEN CHANGED SINCE THEN. AS A REBULT OF AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO WITH THE INDEPENDENT STATES OF EUTEWANA, LESUTHO. MUZARBIQUE, NARIBIA, SWAZILAND AND/OR ZIMBABNE.

- 3.4. COURSE AGREES THAT AT THE TIME THAT THE ELECTIONS TAKE PLACE. PERSONS WHO ARE OTHERWISE SOUTH AFRICAN. HAY NOT BE REBIDENT WITHIN THE TERRITORY DEFINED UNDER 3.3. ABOVE. HEASURES WILL THEREFURE BE TAKEN TO ENSURE THAT THEBE HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SAID ELECTIONS.
 - 4.0. COUEBA AGREES THAT SEATS WILL SE ALLOCATED TO THE CONTENDING PARTIES ON THE BABIS OF PROPORTIONAL REPEEBENTATION.
 - 4.1. CODERA AGREES THAT THE CONTENDING PARTIES WILL PRESENT THEIR CANDIDATES IN NATIONAL PARTY LISTS, TREATING THE COUNTRY AS ONE CONSTITUENCY.
 - 4.2. COURSE ASSETS THAT FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE ELECTION OF THE CONSTITUTION-HAKING BODY, NO HATICHAL VOTERS BOLL WILL SE PREPARED.
 - 4.3. CHURBA AGREES THAT ALL NECESSARY STEPS WILL SE TAKEN TO ENSURE THAT ALL THOSE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE WILL SE ISSUEL WITH THE NECESSARY IDENTITY DECEMBER:

5.0. COMERA AGREES THAT AN ELECTURAL COMMISSION WILL SE FORMED TO ORGANISE AND SUPERVISE THE SAID FLECTIONS AND UNITERTAKE ALL OTHER MEASURES TO ENSURE THAT THE ELECTIONS AFE FREE AND FAIR.

5.1. CODEBA AGREE THAT THIS ELECTORAL COMMISSION WILL BE COMPOSED OF BOUTH AFRICANS. CHOSEN BY CODERA. ON THE BASIS THAT THEY ARE PERSONS OF INTEGRITY AND ABILITY, CAPABLE OF CONDUCTING THEIR BUSINESS HOMESTLY, WITHOUT FEAR OR FAVOUR. AND AS A COLLECTIVE. ENJOYING THE BROAD SUPPORT OF CODEBA.

5.2. COURSE AGREES THAT THE NECESSARY LEGISLATION WILL SE ENACTED TO ESTABLISH THE FLECTURAL CONTRISSION AND GRANT IT SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE CONTROL OF THE ELECTORAL PROCESS. WITH FULL POWERS TO VALIDATE AND/OR INVALIDATE THE RESULTS IN PART AND/OR IN FULL.

5.3. CODERA AGENCE THAT THE INTERNATIONAL CEGANICATIONS INVITED TO ATTEMP THE FIRST SESSION OF COLLEGE (DECEMBER 1991), WILL BE VENUESTED TO OBSERVE THE ELECTORAL PROCESS MONTHS AND MAKE THEIR CAN DETERMINATION AB TO WHETHER THE ELECTIONS WERE FREE AND FAIR.

8.0. COTTER AGREES THAT AT THE SAME TIME, THESE SHALL SE. THE STABLISHED AN INTERIN SOVERHENT CHRIST. WITH BOTH

- 9.1. CODEBA AGREER THAT THE COUNCIL WILL BE DEANN FROM THE PARTICIPANTE AT CODEBA.
- 0.2. CODERA AGREER THAT THE COUNCIL WILL TAKE ITS DECISIONS BY SUFFICIENT CONSENSUS.
- 6.3. CODERA AGREER THAT THE TRI-CAMERAL PARLIAMENT AND ALL OTHER LEGISLATIVE BODIES IN THE COUNTRY WILL IMMEDIATELY DISSOLVE.
 - 6.4. CODERA AGREER THAT ALL EXISTING ADMINISTRATIONS IN THE COUNTRY WILL COME UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT COUNCIL.
 - 6.5. CODERA AGREER THAT THE FORM OF EUCH CONTROL HAY VARY.

 - 7.0. CODEBA AGREES THAT THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT COUNCIL WILL BE PUT IN PLACE NOT LATER THAN THERE MONTHS AFTER THE NECESSARY DECISIONS HAVE SEEN TAKEN BY CODEBA.
 - 8.0. CODERA AGREES THAT ELECTIONS TO THE CONSTITUTION MAKING BODY (CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY) WILL TAKE PLACE NO LATER THAN THESE HONTHS AFTER THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE INTERIN GOVERNMENT COUNCIL.
 - 9.0. COURSEA AGREER THAT THE CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY WILL ALSO ACT AS AN INTERIN PARLIAMENT FROM WHICH WILL BE URAIN AN INTERIN EXELUTIVE AUTHORITY.
 - 9.1. COMESA AGREER THAT UNCE THIS HAS HAPPENED. THE.

- 9.2. CODESA AGREES THAT THE CONSTITUENT ASSESSELY WILL TAKE ITS DECISIONS BY A THO-THIRDS MAJORITY.
- 9.3. CODESA AGERCE THAT THE INTERIR PARLIAMENT WILL TAKE ITE DECISIONS BY COMBENERS.
- 10.0. COMBERA AGREES THAT THE CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY WILL COMPLETE ITS WORK NO LATER THAN NINE MONTHS AFTER ITS ELECTION.
- 11.0. CODERA AGREES THAT, UNLESS AGREED BY THE CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY, ALL INTERIN ARRANGEMENTS WILL CEASE TO OPERATE AS BOOK AS A NEW PARLIAMENT AND SOVERMENT HAVE REEN ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NEW CONSTITUTION.
- THE FIRST FIVE YEARS, OR ANY OTHER PERIOD OF TIME. AS A TEAMSITIONAL PERIOD AND INCOMPORATE IN THE CONSTITUTION "BUNBET CLAUSES" WHICH WOULD FALL AWAY AT THE END OF THE BAID PERIOD.
