Agreement on elements of Interim arrangements clauses 1-5:

We believe that:

1. That Women be represented in the interim transition arrangements in order to make ~~inputs~~ in matters that have gender implication when a new ~~democratic~~ constitution is formulated.
2. That Women be represented in such arrangements that will lead to the creation of a transitional executive structure.
3. That the procedures agreed upon by CODESA in the appointment of the transitional executive structure shall amend such procedures to accomodate representation of Women of such provision has not been made.
4. That Women be represented in all CODESA structures, and ~~that~~ in agreements reached at CODESA the Gender issue be addressed through amendments of the terms of reference of Working Groups to include Women.

5. That the Gender issue be taken into consideration in all other aspects of interim/transitional arrangements that still need to be discussed.
6. We believe that we need to ensure the full representation and participation of Women in all CODESA structures and in the current political process leading up to the writing of the Constitution and the coming into being of a non-sexist non-racial united, democratic South Africa.

We therefore propose that the Gender Advisory Committee be known as the Gender Working Committee afforded the same status and power as all the other Working Groups of CODESA.

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
