27 JULY 1995

- Tom and Fran visited the Eastern Cape (East London and Port Elizabeth) on Thursday 20th July and Friday 21 July where we conferred with our Co-ordinators Nkuli Mayenda and Andile.
- We also conferred with the Director of Government Cars in East London around the usage of Government Garage.
- The purpose of the meeting was to launch an investigation into the allegation raised against Nkuli.
- Secondly, to give support on how to run the workshops and reach out to the public.
- We had a workshop with the CEP people in the provinces. The workshop was mounted in order to achieve the following:
 - To keep them abreast of the Second Phase of our process and to solicit input from them around it.
 - Clarify the communication lines between the provinces and our national office.
 - Government car usage.
- Preparation for Public Sector Hearing to be held in August are underway.
- All arrangements have been made and are being communicated to the speakers.
- Donna Greschner will be funded by the CA.
- Justice Durie and Julia Hausermann's airfares were funded by the Commonwealth. Their accommodation, catering and transport in Cape Town will be covered by the CA.
- All staff that will be assisting will be briefed at 10h00 am on 28 July 1995.
- Research has been conducted around the issue of the government garage cars, we met Mr Freitag the Director of Government Garage in the Eastern Cape.

- We also had launched our investigation around this issue with Mrs Venitia Mostert of parliament and as well as Mrs Eakland - head of Government Garage in Cape Town (Head Office of the GG).
- Today (27 July) we are holding a joint Community Liaison / Media Department workshop to work out a joint programme for the Second Phase of the Public Participation Programme.
- We congratulate the members of the Directorate for their invaluable contribution and support they rendered to make our workshop a success.
