I told him that I knew nothing about that except funeral moneys which I subscribe to anybody at any time where there is death due to our custom. I was never beaten up.

On the 11th April, 1963. Two G.I.Ds came to me at work and took me to Bellwell Police Station. They locked me in there. After some days I appeared before the Magistrate at Bellwell Court. Without being told about the change ^{I was} remanded. A week after that the same G.I.Ds questioned me about ^{2nd} which I subscribed to Pogo Congress as a member. I told them that I never did so. The only subscriptions I knew, were for funerals when any person calls around for collection. I have never been a member of any congress.

I cannot remember the month, a bantuc man came to the Hotel where I am working and collected money for the funeral of a man that was knocked down and killed by a car at Sea Point.

I gave him 30^c. He wrote down my name on a list that he had, with the amount of money next to my name.

The list of names was on a sheet of paper about the size of the paper that you are writing on now. There were names and amounts of money from top to about the middle of the page. I do not remember any of the names on the list.

I saw this bantuc man there only once.

I recognize him on a photo shown to me (~~no. 2~~ S no. ~~2~~) (Maroti Rishabhai Gogola).

I did not attend any meeting at the Hotel or elsewhere.

I was never threatened to join Pogo or asked to join Pogo.

I remember in 1960 I was threatened by unknown bantuc men that I will be beaten up if I go to work and if I do not join their organization I think it was P.A.C.

I did however never join this organization.
