GANGSTERISM

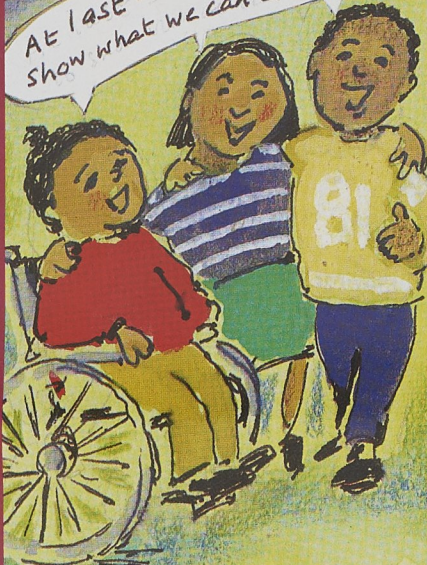

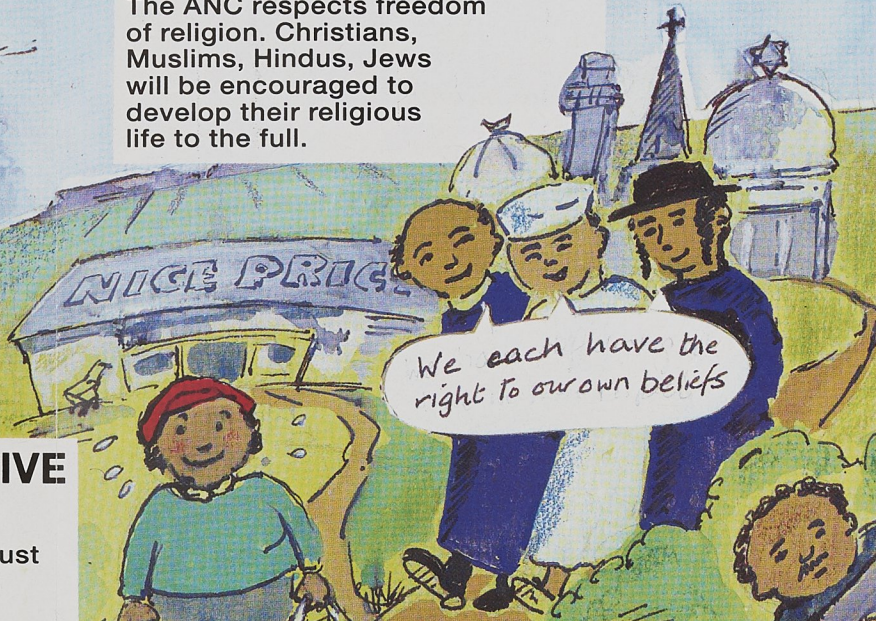


WOMEN

VIOLENCE

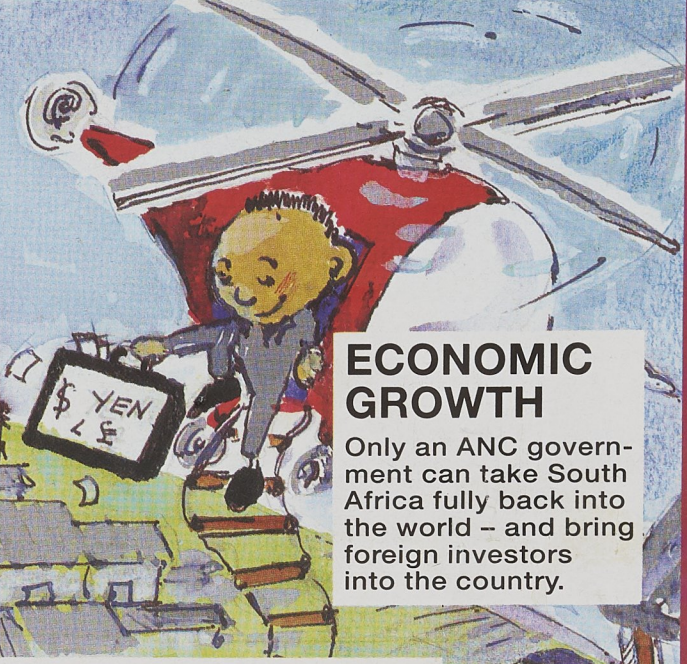

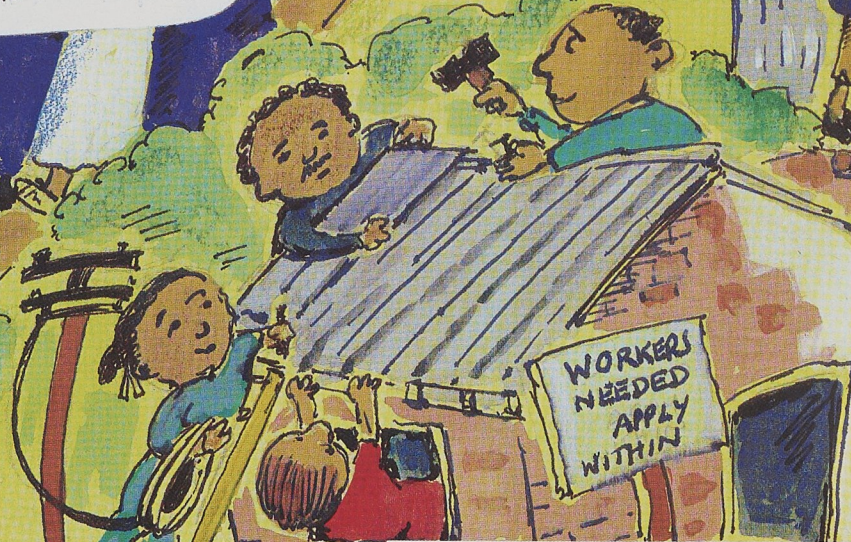
CHILDREN

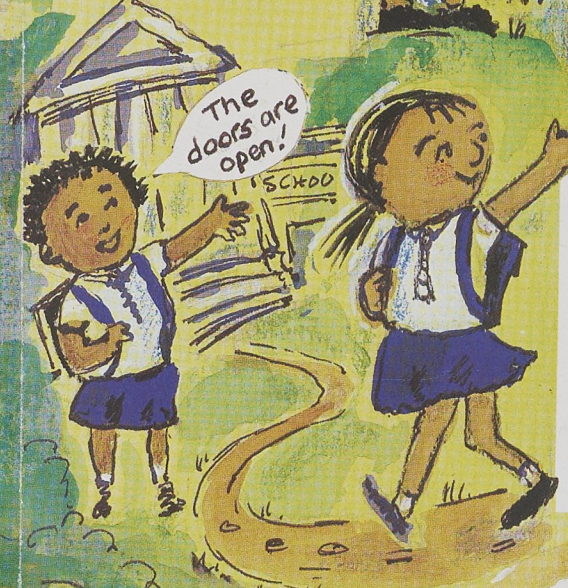
SMALL BUSINESS
