Planning

- Conceptualisation of the Public Participation Programme for the Draft Phase has been completed and distributed to Directorate and all H.O.D.'s

Public Sector Hearings

- Nicci is busy compiling the stakeholders list in terms of breaking it down into organisations.
- This includes removing duplicates and locating provincial, regional and satellite offices.
- MPD invoices for the Traditional Authorities Sector Hearing received.
- MPD paid the CA the R10 000,00 which was due to the CA after the Public Sector Hearing on Justice and the Judiciary.

CPM and Provincial Liaison

- Investigation into the dereliction of duty by SACS people in Empangeni is still in progress.
- The OPS Team is currently working on a proposal for a distribution strategy of the working draft.

- A meeting with the provincial Legislature in Gauteng did not materialise. Instead a meeting was held with the Provincial Sub-committees.
- Maphelo is currently networking with the legislature to ensure a future meeting.

CEP

- Workshops and briefing meetings are still taking place in the provinces.
- In the North West, briefing meeting had to be called off due to local government elections.
- Response to the CEP workshops have been positive.
- The IFP in Paulpietersburg (Northern Natal) requested workshops in the surrounding rural areas. As a response to the request the Co-ordinators have arranged 10 workshops for the area.
- Andile will receive a memorandum/statement from the "Walk to Talk" in East London on 23 September 1995.
- Maphelo will visit East London as part of an investigation into the alleged involvement of Nkuli in an accident.
