At Bellwell they asked me about Pogo, and I told him that I knew nothing. That was on the 28<sup>th</sup> April, 1963. I told him that there came a group of men who asked us to join Pogo in 1962 and I refused. That was in our room at night, and they never came again. I was never beaten up. That's all.

On the 26<sup>th</sup> April, 1963, at something to eleven o'clock <sup>in the morning</sup>, two detectives entered my room, i.e. the above address. They searched my room and afterwards took me to Bellwell Police Station, and locked me in, there. On the 27<sup>th</sup> April, 1963, I appeared before the Magistrate in Bellwell Court, and without being told the charge, I was remanded to the 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 1963. On the 29<sup>th</sup> April, 1963, the same G.I.D.s who brought me to Bellwell, questioned me about Pogo Organisation. I told them that I knew nothing about Pogo activities. I told them that there ~~was~~ <sup>since 1962</sup> a group of ~~men~~ men, whom I can't identify) who asked us to join Pogo and pay 2/6. We refused and they never came back again.

which may incriminate you, but what ever you say will be taken down,  
and it may be used in evidence.

Thereafter I was working at Kastelker Hotel Matlana and I am now working at Silver Leaf Paarden Island.

I am not a member of Pago No one has ever come to me and told me to join and I have never paid any money towards Pago.

I do not know Dorington & Ngwanya or Gogola or Ishongayi.

When I was staying in Lange during last year a lot of bantu came to me in our room. They are unknown to me. They spoke to me and other men in our room about joining Pago. We did not join. I do not know these men.
