At Bellwell they asked me about Pogo, and I told him that I knew nothing.

That was on the 29th April, 1963. I told him that there came a group of men who asked us to join Pogo in 1962, and I refused. That was in our room at night, and they never came again. I was never beaten up. That's all.

On the 26th April, 1963, at something to eleven o'clock ^{in the morning.} there entered two detectives in my room, i.e. the above address. They searched my room and afterwards took me to Bellwell Police Station, and locked me in, there.
On the 27th April, 1963, I appeared before the Magistrate in Bellwell Court, and without being told the charge, I was remanded to the 2nd May, 1963.
On the 29th April, 1963, the same G.I.D. who brought me to Bellwell, questioned me about Pogo Organisation. I told them that I knew nothing about Pogo activities. I told them that there ~~was~~ ^{during 1962} a group of ~~men~~ ^{men} (whom I can't identify) who asked us to join Pogo and pay 2/6^d. We refused and they never came back again.

Jy is, egter, nie verplig om enigiets te sê wat jou mag inkrimineer nie, maar wat jy sê, sal op skrif gestel word en dit mag as getuienis gebruik word.

There are reasonable grounds for suspicion that you are a member of this banned Organization.

This, however, is a very serious matter and I warn to you to be careful what you say. You're not compelled to say anything which may incriminate you, but what ever you say will be taken down, and it may be used in evidence.

months. I do not know what months it was. During this time I was living in a room at Millborough flats. Mill St. East London.

Thereafter I was working at Northwick Hotel Marlton and I am now working at Silverleaf Paradise Island.

I am not a member of Pogo. No one has ever come to me and told me to join and I have never paid any money towards Pogo.

I do not know Dorington & Ngunya or Gogda or Ishongaye.

When I was staying in Long during last year a lot of parties came to me in our room. They are unknown to me. They spoke to me and other men in our room about joining Pogo. We did not join. I do not know these men
