2. Approval of agenda

Point 3.6 of the agenda was amended to read: Rapporteurs and Staffers

Resolved:

- 3.1 That Addenda be attached to minutes as a synopsis of discussions but not have the status of final decisions of meetings.
- 3.2 That corrections to Addenda by delegations be forwarded to the administrators prior to meetings for noting

5. Frequency of meetings

- 5.1 Mr Coetsee proposed that meetings of SubGroups be less frequent due to the unavailability of delegates involved in the forthcoming referendum.
- 5.2 It was agreed that the principle of not allowing outside issues to affect the progress of CODESA should apply in future.
- 5.3 It was accepted that two sessions of every SubGroup should be held over the next three weeks

- That in the event of Mr Madide being unable to Chair the WGSC1 meeting, Mr Pahad would assume 6.4 the Chair.

- Mr Dalling submitted the official report from Subgroup 1 to be forwarded to the DMC for circulation 7.1 to the press
- Mr Coetsee and the ANC reported on distorted reports and leakages to the weekend papers 7.2
- It was accepted that Parties are free to respond to such statements in the media 7.3
- It was reiterated that Draft minutes of meetings should be kept confidential 7.4
- It was accepted that all press statements would be issued via the DMC 7.5

- It was reported by way of information, that Working Group 3 has established from among its delegations, a pool of competent staffers upon which the Working Group can draw as and when 9.1 required.
- Minister Coetsee stated that he felt the services of staffers were essential for delegates due to the 9.2

- 9.3 It was decided that due to time constaints the discussion should be resumed at the next WGSC1 meeting
- 10. SubGroup 3 invitation to the National Peace Accord Committee
- 10.1 Mr Ntusbane explained that there was a misunderstanding between the administration and himself and that the invitation to the National Peace Committee was not submitted
- 10.2 It was reported that the DMC felt that the issue of inviting the National Peace Committee was a sensitive one as CODESA should in no way be seen to be passing judgement on the Peace process.
- 10.3 It was accepted that SG2 liase with the National Peace Accord Committee in order to only gain information required by SG2 to undertake its work.
- 10.4 It was agreed that SG2 request written submissions from the National Peace Committee and Secretariat on specific items on which SG2 requires clarity
- 10.5 It was further agreed that if after the receipt of written submissions it is necessary to have oral representations by the National Peace Committee, this would then be considered by the WGSC1
- 11. Date of next WGSC1 meeting

Resolved:

- 11.1 That due to time constraints the WGSC1 meeting would continue on 2 March, at 12h30 at the WTC.
- 11.3 That only the outstanding issues on the agenda be discussed at the next meeting.
