DEDICATE ourselves in a spirit of goodwill to create a climate for free political representation and set in motion a process of peaceful negotiations conducive to achieving maximum consensus and support which will realise our vision for a new South Africa.

COMMIT ourselves solely to note the decisions of the **CONVENTION FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOUTH AFRICA** and in good faith take all such steps as are within our power and authority to realise their implementation.

DECLARE our commitment to bring about a constitution for a united South Africa as a multiparty democracy which will, when properly authorised by all the people, entrench fundamental human rights under the supremacy of the law.
