Bill of Duties

Duties:

- of the individual

- ~~to~~ not to interfere with his or her neighbour's quiet enjoyment of their land
- to take care of his or ^{her} family
- to take care of his or her land
- to pay the rent

Of the State :-

- to enforce the duties of the individual
- to take care of those unable to take care of themselves
- to take care of unused land
- to collect the rent
- to make available land to those who need it.

11. (1) All men and women are entitled to the peaceful enjoyment of their possessions. The content and limits of their rights of possession shall be determined by laws.
- (2) Property rights impose duties, and their exercise ~~of which~~ should not be in conflict with social interests.

New ANC proposal 11(1)-(4)
combined with old ANC 11(4)-(5)

PLUS

- Surrounding legislation
- land claims court
 - homelessness
 - tenants & labour tenants
 - etc etc

① Guarantee of personal property

- (house, land in connection with personal use, car, etc)
- Protected by proposed 11(1)
- Limits determined by qualification to proposed 11(1) + 11(2)
- Fleshed out by affirmative action clause

② Economic rights / social property

- Industrial / economic property
 - protected by clause on right to private enterprise and commercial activity
 - Balanced by workers' rights and affirmative action clauses
- Social property / land and resources
 - protected by proposed 11(1)
 - Balanced by proposed 11(1) + 11(2) + affirmative action clause

③ Public domain / common ~~rights~~ ^{property}

- Protected by proposed 13: right not to be excluded
- Use determined by laws
- (Parks, roads, beaches, clean environment, wealth in general)
can also include land as resource for shelter and subsistence.
