**PRESS RELEASE BY THE HONOURABLE MR JUSTICE R J GOLDSTONE, CHAIRMAN
OF THE COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY REGARDING PUBLIC VIOLENCE AND
INTIMIDATION**

1. At the request of the Commission, the National Institute for Crime Prevention and Rehabilitation of Offenders (NICRO) has agreed to assist it with its Witness Protection Programme.
2. The type of assistance which NICRO will be able to give will include:
 - (a) Its social workers, in suitable cases, being appointed as security officers to ensure the general welfare of a protected person and to act as a liaison between a protected person and the Commission;
 - (b) Its social workers, in suitable cases, assisting to maintain contact between a protected person and members of his or her family;
 - (c) Assisting a protected person find employment after any period of protection has come to an end;
 - (d) Providing protected persons with educational or reading material and generally rendering such assistance to protected persons which would make periods of protection less oppressive and frustrating.
3. The Commission would like to express its sincere appreciation to NICRO for acceding to its request for this assistance.
